

The Confucius Institute at the University of Texas at Dallas is pleased to announce a 2-week study abroad program from June 3-June 16, 2018 in Nanjing, China. The program is co-organized by CI@UT Dallas and its partner university, Southeast University in Nanjing. It is sponsored by the *Confucius Institute Headquarters (Hanban)*.

### Overview

The study abroad program provides 15 students a two-week experience to live and study at Southeast University in Nanjing, China where students will:

- ★ Attend immersion Chinese language and cultural courses and hands-on workshops
- ★ Experience cultural and social activities with local Chinese students
- ★ Visit places with cultural and historical significance

### Eligibility

Current UTD students who meet at least one of the following requirements:

- ★ Have taken at least one semester of credit or non-credit Chinese language or culture classes (Kung Fu, calligraphy, etc.) at UTD before May 20, 2018.
- ★ Have taken HSK Test (Chinese Language Proficiency Test) and received a fair score (HSK Test Certificate is needed as proof);
- ★ Any proof of Chinese language proficiency that is enough for basic simple daily communication. Please contact Ms. Yan Li for the language proficiency interview.

**CRITICAL INFORMATION:****1. Important Timeline**

- ★ **February 20:** Deadline for submitting the program application form.
- ★ **February 21 – March 20:** Confucius Institute processes and submits the applications to the Confucius Institute Headquarters and Southeast University for approval. Participants and faculty leader start to apply for a passport if they don't have one.
- ★ **May 1st.** Visas ready. (Participants are responsible for securing their own visas.)
- ★ **May 19:** Trip orientation
- ★ **June 2:** Leave for China
- ★ **June 3 – June 15:** Experience China
- ★ **June 16:** Return from China, the program ends.

**2. Passport and Visa**

**Participants are responsible for securing their passports and visas to China by May 1st.**

**3. International Airfare**

UTD will NOT handle the group tickets purchase. You may need to book your own tickets which MUST FIT the group itinerary.
