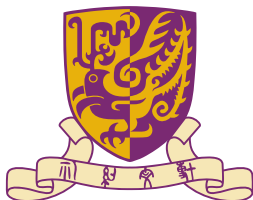

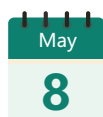

ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

Language

If students are from institutions where English is not the primary language of instruction, they should have a minimum TOEFL score of 530 (paper-based) / 71 (internet-based) or IELTS 6.0 or equivalent.

Academics

Students should currently enroll in a partner university recognised by CUHK-Shenzhen.

Undergraduate students should have completed at least two academic semesters of university studies. Postgraduate students should have a recognised bachelor's degree or equivalent and currently enroll in a postgraduate programme at a partner university.

A minimum cumulated grade point average (cGPA) of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale (B average or better, or equivalent).

CUHK-Shenzhen uses a credit unit system. Criteria of assessment may include any one or a combination of the following: attendance, class work, written work, laboratory work, fieldwork, research papers, tests, examinations, and/or any other assessment. One unit requires 14 contact hours.

Students need to consult their home institutions to confirm whether the credits earned at CUHK-Shenzhen can be transferred.

Study load

Minimum: 9 units per semester

Maximum: 18 units per semester

ACCOMMODATION

A unique college system is adopted in CUHK-Shenzhen. Colleges are congenial communities with their own hostels, dining halls, and other facilities. They are where students receive pastoral care and whole-person education and are offered exciting palettes with which to colour their university life. There are four colleges on campus, namely Shaw College, Diligentia College, Muse College and Harmonia College. On-campus housing is automatically assigned to the admitted students. For the students who have special requirements, please consult the Office of Academic Links at least one month before arrival.



► **Check-in:**

Earliest check-in date for the Fall Semester is a week before semester begins, for the Spring Semester is 4 January.

► **Check-out:**

No later than a week after exams end

► **Room type:**

4-bed dormitory, shared bathroom

Note: On-campus accommodation is not guaranteed due to limited capacities.

INSURANCE

International incoming students are required to purchase global medical insurance and personal accident injury insurance BEFORE coming to China.

FEES & EXPENSES

Housing (4-bed dormitory):	CNY 600/student/semester; CNY 1,200/student/year
Housing Deposit:	CNY 800 /student (refundable if there is no damage to the room when the students check out)
On-campus meals:	about CNY 2,400/month
Books, course materials:	about CNY 900/semester
Health check:	CNY 500-800
Residence Permit:	CNY 400-800 depending on the length of stay

VISA & RESIDENCE PERMIT

International incoming students are required to enter the Chinese mainland with an X visa (student visa).

X1 visa: Issued to those who intend to study for a period of more than 180 days.

X2 visa: Issued to those who intend to study for a period of no more than 180 days.

The X visa is for single entry. Students must apply for the Residence Permit within 30 days after arrival in order to obtain the multiple entries qualification. Detailed information about the application procedures of Residence Permit will be provided after students' arrival.



Steps to apply for Visa and Residence Permit:

- 1 Students receive CUHK-Shenzhen Acceptance Letter and JW202 Form at least one month before a semester begins.
- 2 Students apply for Chinese X visa at a Chinese embassy or consulate.
- 3 Students enter the Chinese mainland with the visa.
- 4 Students apply for Residence Permit after registration with CUHK-Shenzhen.

Please note:

1. For the latest information regarding visa application, please contact your nearest Embassy/Consulate of China.
2. After students arriving in the Chinese mainland, the X visa for single entry cannot allow students to exit and re-entry the Chinese mainland. Students must stay in the Chinese mainland until the Residence Permit is granted.
3. International incoming students need to register at the local police office with the help of OAL within 24 hours after entering the Chinese mainland.



PROGRAMME & ACTIVITY

Orientation

A mandatory orientation for the incoming students is usually arranged on the last Friday or Saturday before a semester begins. The orientation covers an introduction to CUHK-Shenzhen and Shenzhen city, course selection, residence permit application, and tips for life and study at CUHK-Shenzhen. A campus tour will also be arranged.

Experience China

“Experience China” is a series of activities organized by the Office of Academic Links aiming to help international incoming students understand Chinese culture, history and development. Usually it includes a city tour, cultural activities, company visits, etc.

Student Clubs

There are over 66 student clubs. Meeting new friends and participating in club activities will help incoming students make the most of their study experience in China.

International Day

The International Day is an annual event. It is an opportunity for international students at CUHK-Shenzhen to exhibit their home country/region and to promote their home universities.

Incoming exchange/visiting students have access to library, the sports hall, gyms and the campus shuttle bus.

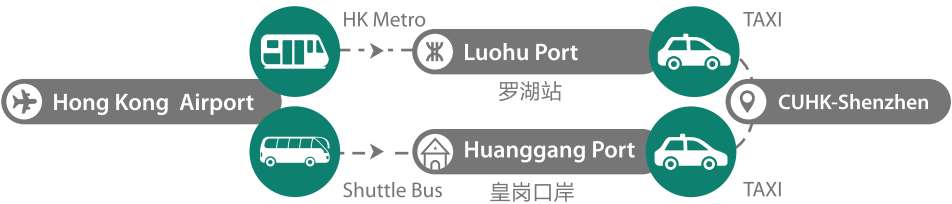


Transportation to CUHK-Shenzhen

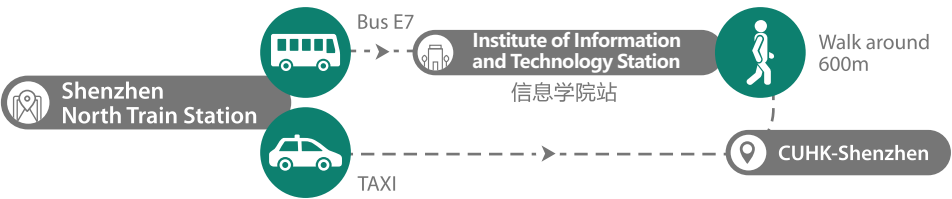
1 From Shenzhen Bao'an Airport
